I'm pleased to confirm that BIWATER – BUILDING DEVELOPMENT HOLDING JOINT VENTURE substantially completed on 4th March 2011 the EIB funded project "Design and Construction of Waste Water Treatment Plant for the City of Haskovo", Contract No. EIB/FA/971999/W/BG signed with the Ministry of Regional Development and Public Works of Bulgaria – ISPA IA on 27th July 2004.

In accordance with the Updated Consortium Agreement dated 27th October 2007 the total contract amount of **Euro 16,091,361.57** has been spitted between the partners as follow:

- Biwater, England as the Partner Euro <u>1,384,415.30</u>; and
- Building Development Holding, Bulgaria as the Leader Euro 14,706,946.27.

WWTP Haskovo has been designed and constructed using Biological treatment process with activated sludge, Extended Aeration method for 100,000 People Equivalent with Maximum Flow to Treatment of 3,000 cub.m. per hour. The scope of works also includes construction of 3.6 km of the main collector in diameter 1500 & 2000 mm with river crossing and of 1.5 km of sub-collectors in diameter 800 – 1500 mm with two railway crossings each 42 m long using casing pipes of 2200 mm diameter.
